THE LIGHT

in our eyes

In these final weeks before our 150th anniversary celebration, I have found myself thinking a lot about our foundress, Alice Mary Thorpe. I picture her as a woman of deep faith, a woman whose determination and compassion shone as a beacon, attracting others to join her in serving the neglected and impoverished women and children of her day.

Then I think about myself—one who stands on the shoulders of our Congregation's early Sisters. I don't know about you, but I don't usually feel much like a shining star or beacon of light leading the way for others. In fact, sometimes I even find myself edging toward the shadows, doing my best not to be seen at all. (Maybe I'm frightened by the prospect of my flaws being seen, my hidden failings revealed.)

Of course, light simply allows the truth to be seen. And the more clearly we are able to see who we really are (warts and all!), the more we come to appreciate how great God's unconditional love for us must be. Light reveals the truth—of who we are and *how much God loves us!*

So what are we to make of the gospel imperative to *be light* for the world? Perhaps it is not so much about *our*

goodness as it is about *God's* love. If we keep our eyes on Jesus, the perfect self-revelation of that love, the long-promised "light of the world" (John 8:12), we cannot fail to reflect the radiance of God's love in our own eyes. And whenever we do, we become beacons of God's compassion as we embrace our mission to serve the neglected and powerless of our time. ●

Welcome Day

As part of their 150-year celebration of service, the Dominican Sisters hosted a Welcome Day at their motherhouse in Sparkill, New York, on Saturday, Sept. 13, 2025, from 1:00 to 5:00 p.m., with more than 250 people in attendance.

Sister Irene Ellis, OP, Prioress of the Congregation, warmly welcomed everyone. At one point, she said, "The Dominican Sisters of Sparkill are part of the worldwide Dominican Family founded by Saint Dominic in the 13th century. Since our founding by Alice Mary Thorpe in 1876 to care for destitute women and children in New York City, we have continued to serve the people of New York and remain attentive to the cries of the most vulnerable and the suffering people of our time." Her words were followed by a special 150th anniversary video that described the mission and ministry of the Sisters since 1876 to the present day.

Displays created by the Sisters and Associates highlighted many of the ministries in which the Congregation has participated over the decades, when they have served as school administrators and teachers at all levels of

education, childcare workers, social workers, nurses, artists, counselors, spiritual directors, librarians, and researchers in Missouri (1900), Pakistan (1958), Montana (1973), Peru (1979), Botswana and Muan, Africa (1979/1983), Arizona (1990), Lithuania (1995), and many parts of the United States.

Exhibitions of current ministries were also displayed, such as Days for Girls, One-to-One Learning, Albertus Magnus High School, St. Thomas Aquinas College, the Associates Program, Thorpe and Dowling Senior Housing, and efforts by the Justice Committee with Anti-Gun Violence, *Laudato Si'*, and Mission Outreach.

The day was festive as long time friends, collaborators, students, and teachers met again after many years. Delicious food, renewed friendships, and stories filled with laughter were generously shared. A closing liturgy in Dominican Convent Chapel was celebrated with uplifting music and gratitude to God.

This milestone event marks 15 decades of dedicated service, prayer, and compassionate ministry—an anniversary too meaningful to keep quiet!

A LEGACY OF LOVE

Sister Jeanne Margaret Stoltz, OP

“How could I not love the Sparkill Dominicans? They were the only sisters I ever knew, and I loved every one of them. They taught me, formed me, and became my family.”

For Sister Jeanne Margaret Stoltz, OP, ministry was never simply a place of work—it was a lifelong expression of love, faith, and service. A Dominican Sister of Sparkill since 1945, Sister Jeanne devoted her life to Catholic education, touching generations of students across parish schools and, most notably, St. Dominic’s High School in O’Fallon, Missouri—her longest and most influential ministry.

Raised in St. Louis and educated by Dominican Sisters, Sister Jeanne Margaret felt her call to religious life while still in St. Mark High School. That call led her to Sparkill shortly after graduation and into a vocation that would span more than 80 years. Her early ministries included teaching at St. Helena’s in the Bronx, followed by many years in St. Louis parish schools. She taught first grade for 17 years, serving at Little Flower Parish in Richmond Heights, Missouri, and later helped to establish the newly formed St. Simon’s Parish in south St. Louis.

In the early years of St. Dominic’s High School, Sister Jeanne was assigned—quite suddenly—to the growing school in O’Fallon. What began as an unexpected transition became the heart of her work. At the time, St. Dominic’s was only two years old, with just a few hundred students. Sister Jeanne served as both English teacher and librarian,

eventually dedicating herself fully to the library—a role that allowed her to support students, faculty, and curriculum across every grade level.

For more than four decades, Sister Jeanne became a familiar and beloved presence at St. Dominic’s. The library was more than a place for books—it was a refuge. Students knew they could find help, encouragement, or simply a listening ear. Though trained in Elementary Education and Library Science, it was her compassion and genuine interest in each student that defined her ministry. She made it her mission to know all 600 students, treating the school not as an institution, but as a family. She said,

“I cared about every one of them. Whether they needed help, a prayer, or someone to listen, that’s why I was there.”

Prayer and faith were woven naturally into her daily interactions. Whether beginning classes with prayer or inviting students to lead their own, Sister Jeanne gently taught that prayer was an essential part of life. Her most treasured memory came during her 50th jubilee, when she requested that the entire school pray the rosary together. The result—a “living rosary” formed by students and faculty in the gym—became a lasting tradition that continues each May in her honor.

Even after retirement, Sister Jeanne remained closely connected to St. Dominic’s, returning for major celebrations and witnessing the school’s remarkable growth into one of the largest co-ed Catholic high schools in the state. Former students, now parents and grandparents, still recognize her influence and share stories of her kindness and faith.

Today, Sister Jeanne continues her quiet ministry of prayer, guided by a simple hourly reflection, asking God to place love in her heart so others may encounter God through her. It is the same prayer she has lived out for decades—especially at St. Dominic’s, where her legacy of compassion, prayer, and community continues to flourish. ●

THE 125TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION OF THE SPARKILL DOMINICANS IN *Missouri*

On a beautiful bright sunny day, Oct. 5, 2025, the Sparkill Dominicans celebrated their 125th Anniversary of Ministry in Missouri at Holy Spirit Church. Officiating at the Eucharistic Celebration was Most Rev. Mitchell Rozanski, Archbishop of the St. Louis Diocese, and five other priests.

This day was chosen because it was the closest Sunday to the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, our Congregational Patron. The Sparkill Dominicans have an old favorite hymn, Queen of the Holy Rosary, which contains the words “Dear Source of love untold Refuse not this our offering, flowers white, red and gold.”

Everyone helped. Sister Chris Gamache put together the list of invitees to enhance the printing and mailing of the invitations. She also took the role of greeter and handed out the programs. Our Prioress, Sister Irene Ellis, OP, opened the celebration with an address to the attendees about our history and services as Sparkill Dominicans.

A Dominican Sisters Association Receives Canonical Approval: ***Shared Governance for Life and Mission***

A newly formed Dominican Sisters Association (DSA) has been approved by the Vatican, marking a milestone in the life and mission of Dominican women religious in the northeastern United States. The five Dominican Congregations include: the Dominican Sisters of Amityville (NY), Blauvelt (NY), Caldwell (NJ), Hope (NY), and Sparkill (NY). The Sisters are committed to a shared mission of preaching the Gospel through justice, truth-seeking, and compassion.

The DSA represents an important step forward in religious life, as these five Dominican congregations have come together in a model of shared governance. The Association will support member congregations in planning for a future in which they may no longer have the capacity to exercise canonical governance independently.

This journey began in 2019, as the congregations entered into a discernment process, exploring how best to sustain and advance Dominican life and mission into the future. In 2022, the five congregations petitioned the Apostolic See to canonically establish the Association, which was approved in 2025. Sister Carmen Rosa Nortes, NSC, undersecretary of the Society of Apostolic Life, wrote in her letter accompanying the official decree, “May this association among Dominican Sisters support each institute in living faithfully the call of the Lord to consecrated life in the Dominican tradition, embodying your motto *Veritas et Caritas*.”

The result is a transformative model of governance that seeks to ensure continued vitality and relevance in a rapidly changing world. On June 14, 2025, the Dominican Sisters Association held its inaugural assembly a day of prayer, dialogue, ritual, and joyful celebration. The day opened with a moving ceremony honoring the five founding congregations and the generations of women who have carried forward the Dominican mission with courage and fidelity.

During the assembly, participants finalized the DSA Focus Statement and elected the first President and Executive Committee, which are tasked with leading the DSA into this next chapter with wisdom and shared commitment. The members of the inaugural DSA Executive Committee are: Sister Mary Hughes, OP, Amityville; Sister Theresa Rickard, OP, President, Blauvelt; Sister Pat Tavis, OP, Caldwell; Sister Connie Kelly, OP, Hope; and Sister Mary Murray, OP, Sparkill.

As members of the Dominican Sisters Association step boldly into this next phase, they do so rooted in their common charism of preaching the Gospel, united by a passion for mission, and committed to igniting their future together in a new way. ●

On Friday, May 9, 2025, One to One Learning, Inc.—a sponsored ministry of the Dominican Sisters of Sparkill—celebrated 28 years of empowering immigrants at its annual Hands of Hope Gala held at the Nyack Seaport. The program marked a banner year for One to One, with 350 students enrolled in English classes and the addition of six new volunteer teachers, further strengthening its mission of support through education and community.

In her remarks, Sister Cecilia LaPietra, OP, founder and executive director, reflected on the organization's guiding vision:

Whether marching in the streets, meeting with lawmakers, or working alongside justice and peace organizations, she is the public face of the Sisters' justice efforts.

ENCUENTRO MEETING IN *St. Louis*

The Dominican Sisters Conference invited leaders and a cohort of members and Associates from US Dominican Women's Congregations to gather for an *Encuentro* in St. Louis, Missouri, in October 2025. In Spanish, *Encuentro* translates to "encounter/meeting," and is a time of prayer, reflection, and collective discernment, exploring where the Spirit is calling us and the work that is needed to lead us into the future.

The theme, "Preachers of Hope for Times Such as These," set the stage for more than 250 attendees to discern and work together. The atmosphere was one of energy and joy. The talks by Sisters Margaret Mayce and Christine Atienza, used at the circles, invited challenge and hope. Great enthusiasm and energy filled the room as the group discussed the possibilities for ministry now and in the future.

Sister Joan Correia, OP, said, "Our reality, as Sparkill Dominicans, finds a comfortable home in the larger Dominican Family. We bring our spirit of joy and hospitality. We need to continue to listen to one another and accept change with that same spirit of joy."

Sister Paulette Patrilli, OP, went to *Encuentro* not knowing what to expect but said that everyone was so welcoming and "from the very beginning, it was as if we had known each other forever. We all had the same agenda: How do we continue to share the Dominican charism in our world today? We didn't talk about diminishment; instead, we talked about our future—our hopes as we move forward."

Sister Jeannine DeClue, OP, described *Encuentro* as "an advent, a waiting that makes our longing more intense. *Encuentro* encourages us to stay awake with patience, waiting for a new understanding of how to be Dominican. As Sparkill Dominicans, we have so much to give of our lived experience, but mostly, I feel we have much to learn. I was edified by our Dominican Associates, who bring new perspectives to our decisions ... We claim joy as unique to Sparkill, but there was joy all around, and hospitality. Throughout the meetings, our sharing was contemplative and came from a deep place of our hearts, and we listened to God, to the holy preaching, to music, and to each other.

Sister Mary Jane Bookstaver, OP, remarked, "We are much more alike than different. I was moved by the opening ritual when, as each congregation's banner was presented, that congregation stood and declared its mission statement. The concepts in the statements were almost identical, which spoke volumes to me of our oneness as the Dominican family. After each congregation's mission statements

were read, all of the DSA members were asked to stand and read the DSA mission statement. That brought home to me our connectedness. We are all one family as part of the worldwide Dominican Order."

Sister Sheila Brennan, OP, shared, "When I entered, I did not know there were any other Dominican communities, only Sparkill Dominicans in St. Louis. I am comfortable within the larger Dominican world now. I see Sparkill leading the way in joy and hospitality. We have already welcomed two groups of sisters to share our home. Knowing that Dominicans across the US are collaborating more, I see a future where we will be united even closer." ●




Cyclists, walkers, and runners followed two marked routes on the properties. Everyone who registered received a free T-shirt and enjoyed the food, contests, and games.
